In order to help design what needs to be done and to get the pulse of the congregation, the group is sending out this survey document and strongly urges everyone to prayerfully complete the survey and return it to the church. Otherwise you will be receiving it via snail mail and you can mail it back to the church.

The minimum conditions given by the CDC and the New England Conference that would need to be in place before a to return to in person worship services are the following:

- Face coverings for everyone
- Six foot spacing
- Limit of fifty people in attendance
- No use of common materials such as hymnals, bibles, friendship pads, prayer request cards, etc.
- No passing of the offering plate.
- No congregational singing or vocal choirs

- Disinfecting common touch surfaces between services unless a 7-day vacancy between services.
- No food or coffee served before or after a service.
